Today's hiking route leads to the spot that made us fall in love with Parga and its surroundings. The earlier you start and the further you venture from Parga, the quieter it becomes. The entire hike takes about an hour, but it's quite a climb. Take it easy in warm weather and enjoy the breathtaking views along the way.

The first part of the route is an adventurous goat path. If you find that too challenging, opt for the alternative route. Don't forget to bring plenty of water. Once you reach the top, you'll find a charming little church where you can walk a bit further up to a stone bench. Here, you can peacefully enjoy the spectacular view of the surroundings.

It's no wonder so many people keep coming back for this hike. In the church, you can light a candle (leave some money for this) and leave a message in the guestbook.

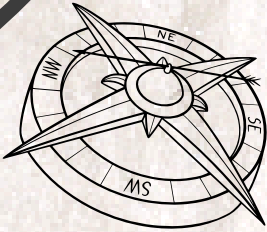

## User Responsibility:

- **Own Risk:** Whether you're getting in the car or lacing up your hiking boots, remember that you are the captain of this ship. We're happy to provide the route, but you're in control!
- **Local Laws and Traffic Rules:** Adhere to traffic rules and laws. We know the shortest path through the field might be tempting, but stick to the paths (and stay out of the farmer's olive grove).
- **Safety and Preparation:** Make sure you're well-prepared. Check the weather, bring enough snacks (no one wants to be a hungry adventurer), and don't forget your water bottle. And sturdy hiking boots if you're going hiking
- **Health and Physical Condition:** We trust you know what you can handle. If that steep mountain calls, listen to your knees and back. Take it easy if you're unsure.
- **Emergencies:** In case you find yourself in a situation even Bear Grylls would avoid, know how to call for help. Better to make one call too many than too few! (Emergency services: 112, Police: 100, Ambulance: 166, Fire department: 199, and also note the phone number of your car rental service here...)
